The series features stories of transformation that include:

- Alice Marie Johnson: A former federal prisoner who was granted clemency by then-President Donald Trump in 2018, Alice details how her life experiences have empowered her to lead with compassion, fight for criminal justice reform, and humanize the women and men who are still incarcerated. By treating people with respect, she believes we will find the humanity in one another to solve problems together.
- <u>Tony McAleer</u>: A former white supremacist, Tony details his journey from violent extremism to radical compassion. He now helps others leave hate groups and find genuine connection to humanity through vulnerability and compassion.
- <u>Leon Ford</u>: Tragically and mistakenly shot by the police in 2012, Leon shares his life-changing journey of leveraging his painful experience to foster understanding and collaboration between public safety officials and communities. He reminds people of the importance of building relationships and respect for one another regardless of differing opinions.

"Nominees like *Radical Heroes* are setting the standard for innovation and creativity on the Internet," said Nick Borenstein, General Manager of The Webby Awards. "It is an incredible achievement to be selected among the best from the nearly 13,000 entries we received this year."
